



RESERVE WINES

CHIMNEY ROCK CABERNET SAUVIGNON TOMAHAWK VINEYARD 2015 (Napa, CA) \$300

Vinous 93 points - The 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Tomahawk Vineyard is one of the most distinctive wines in the range. Inky dark red/purplish fruit, leather, smoke, licorice, tobacco and menthol give the wine much of its personality. This is an especially plush, resonant wine with tons of Stags Leap character and plenty of style.

FAUST "THE PACT" CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018 (Napa, CA) \$240

James Suckling 93 points- 83% Cabernet Sauvignon blended with Merlot, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. Aromas of black Currants, cedar, chocolate & cherry. Shows finesse & focus.

CADE HOWELL MOUNTAIN CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017 (Napa, CA) \$240

Wine Enthusiast 95 points -. 88% Cabernet Sauvignon with Malbec, Petit Verdot and Merlot. Blueberry, blackberry, coffee, clove & mint on the nose. Dark fruit & cherry flavors with cola, vanilla and chocolate truffles on the finish.

TERRA VALENTINE CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016 (Spring Mountain District, CA) \$145

James Suckling 93 points - This offers a spicy impression with a wealth of intense, rich and dark fruit aromas, leading to a rich, fleshy palate that offers a very vibrant, nicely structured and fresh finish. Neat wine with impressive depth. A blend of 96 per cent cabernet sauvignon, the rest merlot.

BLACK STALLION TRANSCENDENT 2015 (Napa, CA) \$235

Deep garnet in hue, Transcendent Cabernet Sauvignon is layered, complex and rich, boasting exquisite aromas of blackberry and violet. Indulgent notes of caramel frame a generous core of ripe, black fruit flavors accentuated by subtle hints of toffee and mocha.

CAKEBREAD CELLARS CABERNET SAUVIGNON VINE HILL 2017 (Napa, CA) \$295

Fresh, high-toned aromas of blackberry, fig, floral spice, earth, flint and cocoa introduce intense, focused black fruit flavors and dark chocolate tones, bright acidity and full body. The wines then underwent a three-week maceration before maturing for 22 months in French oak barrels (48% new).

DOMINUS ESTATE 2017 (Napa, CA) \$525

Wine Enthusiast 96 points - A blend of 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Cabernet Franc and 5% Petit Verdot, this classically structured red is luxurious in aromas of dried herb, cedar and clove. The palate balances rich fruit and dense oak with underlying freshness and longevity. The tannins are grippy yet seamless, and beginning to smooth out.



FAR NIENTE CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY 2018 (Napa, CA) \$225

Wine Enthusiast 95 points - This memorable Cabernet Sauvignon has small amounts of Petit Verdot, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Malbec blended in. Aged 17 months in a majority of new French oak, it unfurls flavors of red fruit, dried herb and clove over a core of youthful tannin and spicy oak.

ROBERT MONDAVI CABERNET SAUVIGNON RESERVE 2015 (Napa, CA) \$250

James Suckling 93 points - This is a big and full-throttle cabernet with lots of muscle and ripe fruit. Walnuts. Dried fruit. Some black truffle, too. Heady and rich. Old-school style.

OPUS ONE RED 2017 (Napa, CA) \$500

James Suckling 95 points - Lots of currant and floral notes on the nose. Hints of mint and spice. Medium-to full-bodied, round and savory with creamy, juicy tannins. Hints of citrus underneath. Bright, fresh and delicious.

PLUMPJACK MERLOT 2018 (Napa, CA) \$140

Wine Advocate 92 points - A complex nose of black cherry, plum and cut flowers followed by cardamom, cocoa and vanilla. Complex flavors of cherries, berries and herbs wrapped in a creamy texture

VIETTI BAROLO RIVERA 2017 (Piedmont, Italy) \$350

Wine Advocate 95 points - Opens to complex floral notes and then hints of red fruit and white pepper. Ripe fruit on the palate with taut, compact tannins making this a very classic Wine. Vibrant, great acidity and refined.

TENUTA GUADO AL TASSO SUPERIORE 2017 (Bolgheri, Italy) \$250

Wine Advocate 97 points - From a warm and sunny vintage that produced darkly concentrated fruit, the Tenuta Guado al Tasso is a teaser and a super pleaser. This is one flashy wine. This carefully calculated blend of 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc and 15% Merlot pours from the bottle with a beautifully saturated and rich color.

GAJA BARBARESCO 2017 (Piedmont, Italy) \$500

Wine Advocate 95 points - The Gaja 2017 Barbaresco is nuanced and delicate with ever-expanding aromatic intensity that amply fills the balloon of your glass. The wine takes a little while to open fully, and it slowly releases forest berry, powdered licorice, toasted aniseed, spearmint, dried lavender and rosemary essence to build a lasting bouquet. The mouthfeel is streamlined and almost steely, with an extremely linear approach that adds to its length and persistency.
